This was to bring together the Arabic, Jewish and Russian congregations in Akko for prayer. It was a warm sultry evening as we came together at the lighthouse in the Old City of Akko. There was apprehension in the air because Arabs and Jews, believers or not, do not usually unite together. We started by introducing ourselves. And after a short explanation of the power of coming together as one body, we began to worship. "Everyone understood"! Smiles broke on faces; tears started flowing, followed by the most awe-inspiring, Holy Spirit lead time of prayer. There was much rejoicing, as cries of feeling like walls have come down, and the need to continue this in the future were shared.

We had a few different congregations along with 4 Pastors from South Carolina visit our church. As we toured Israel and worshipped together we started to develop a strong bond with each other. They were some great people. The group performed a few skits that spoke to the hearts of children and adults. After this, Pastor Doyle spoke a powerful message, followed by words of knowledge and encouragement. Thank you guys!

Another wonderful evening was spent worshipping with The Redeemer Praise Team from Alliance Church in Jerusalem. Oh my... I have to say, this group is one on-fire, Holy Spirit filled team. They shook the Heavens and Earth with Glory filled praise to God, after which Pastor Mazen Nasrawi gave a wonderful message. The Spirit was moving as many of the believers experienced God in a new way while Pastor Mazen, Simeon, Pastor Jack Sara and Pastor Hani prayed for and layed hands on them.
