This stirred up a conversation between us in which we found out that they were from a Baptist church. Two of the Pastors were so touched with our presence and works in Akko that right after they left, they came running back to us to say that God put it on their hearts to donate some money to the church. Wow... praise God. This was an unexpected blessing, one that was born out of our needs, and initiated through you and our joint prayer.

We had another exciting answer to prayer. Remember in our last newsletter I had asked you to pray for Pastor Hani's trip to the US Embassy? He was trying to get a visa to the US so he could travel there in order to raise prayer and financial support. Well, they not only gave him a visa, but it is a 10 year, multiple re-entry visa. Praise God! Again, thank you for your prayers.

These past few months have been very busy for us. We kicked things off with Pastor David and some members of his church in North Carolina ministering to our youth with games and skits. This was followed by Pastor Henry from Jerusalem who came with a group of believers from different countries to share the Gospel to the Muslims in Akko's Old City through street evangelism and music. The Old City has its share of drug abusers. However, thanks to these people, a few of them who had ears to hear gave their hearts to the Lord right on the street. Even the Muslim manager of the Hostel in which they were staying got a chance to receive seeds of fruit as they played music and witnessed to him.

In May, Pastor Hani went to the Golan Hotel in Tiberius and had the chance to speak about our church heart and vision before Pastor Steve and many of the other leaders of the Ell El ministry. Ell El is a ministry that ministers healing via Biblical teachings to those with deep down emotional pain.

Two events that clearly stand out though, are the Global Day of Prayer and the Back to Jerusalem conference. Pastor Ray, his wife, Renee and Ed came to our church to do some Biblical training before the GD of P. They were such a blessing to have with us. The Global day of Prayer is on Pentecost Sunday. Gathered together for the second year in a row in the Golden Crown Hotel in Nazareth, were Arab and Jewish believers. There is nothing like seeing two people groups that would have normally been at odds with each other, now joined in love through the power of the Holy Spirit. Oh... and how that Spirit fell, again!

Now fast forward to the Back to Jerusalem conference where we get to see the working out of the Holy Spirits' power through the spreading of the Gospel. At the conference we had about 300 people, many of whom were visitors from around the world. It was such an encouragement to us as we were treated to exhortations by wonderfully gifted speakers. The conference is partially funded by the Joshua Fund. This year, we were very much blessed to have Joel Rosenberg, who is the head of the Joshua Fund, attend. He spoke and encouraged us with testimonies of how God is moving amongst the nations, and gave a thought provoking word from the book of Joel. As in the past, during one part of the conference, the people break up into different groups and go into areas in and around Jerusalem to hand out packets filled with Bibles, a book of testimonies and a DVD of the Jesus movie to the Muslims. Many people came back with stories of how God had moved the hearts of Muslims to pray with them. When the conference is over, the visitors are divided up and go back with the local body to each other's respective town or village. For the next week we each give out the packets again to the Muslims. This year we were blessed to have 3 wonderful people come back with us to Akko, Denise, Rose and Brody. They were such a help in the Lord's work. One day we gave out a special invitational card to the Muslims in town and along the beach. This card invited them to a free showing of the movie, The Road to Damascus, in the town auditorium which we rented with funding from the conference. The movie showed the story of Saul/Paul, his conversion on the road to Damascus and his influence amongst the people of his time. It was so exciting to see many of the Arab families that we gave the card to attend.
